WTF Gallery presents sculpture installation, *Face, Faith, Fake* by Jakraphun Thanateeranon. This exhibition has been conceptualised over the last six years during his art residency programmes and participation in artistic activities throughout Europe and Asia. For this show he created over 120 interactive ceramic sculptures of human heads that were created at Thao Hong Thai Ceramics Factory in Ratchaburi.

Jakraphun articulates changes in human behavior influenced by fast-moving technology through various personas presented in his interactive sculptures. Inspired by the rapid increase of humans' interaction with social media, rather than face-to-face interaction, he expresses his concerns with obscurity, deception, soullessness, obsession and addiction that seems to flourish via these networks.
